DwightBEING A BY-LAW TO RESTRICT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS. * MARK ✓
(Rescinding By-law #97-23) ✓

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge is desirous of prohibiting the discharge of guns and other firearms in certain areas of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Section 210, Para. 36 the Corporation of the Town of Bracebridge is permitted to prohibit the discharge of guns or other firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any class or type thereof in any defined area;


THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF BRACEBRIDGE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That no person shall discharge a gun or other firearm in those parts of the Town of Bracebridge, in the District Municipality of Muskoka as shown on Schedule "A" attached., and more particularly described in Schedule "B" also attached.
2. That a person or persons actively operating a farm as a significant source of income will be exempt to the regulations of this by-law when and only when engaged in the control of wildlife including but not limited to vermin and pigeons, for the protection of livestock and/or crops
3. That Registered Charitable Organizations and/or Recognized Service Clubs shall be eligible to make application to the Municipality for exemption to this by-law for the purpose of holding fundraising events;
4. That no person shall discharge a gun or other firearms, air gun, spring gun, crossbow, longbow, or any class thereof within 300 metres of a school.
- 5.. That this by-law shall be enforced by the "By-Law Enforcement" officers.
6. That every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and shall be subject to a penalty in accordance with the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, c. P.33.
7. That every person guilty of an offence under this by-law may, if permitted under the Provincial Offences Act, pay a set fine, and the Chief Judge of the Ontario Court (Provincial Division) shall be requested to establish, pursuant to the Provincial Offences Act, set fines in accordance with Schedule "C" of this by-law.
8. That By-Law #97-23 as passed by the Council of the Town of Bracebridge on the 2nd day of April 1997 be rescinded and that this by-law shall take effect as of the date of passing. ✗



Schedule "B"
To By-law 99-33

Bracebridge Ward.

1. All properties lying within Bracebridge Ward of the Town of Bracebridge.

Muskoka Ward

1. Block A, Concession 13 within 100 metres of the shoreline of any body of water. On the remainder of Block A, Concession 13, *25 caliber and under guns, shotguns and muzzle loaders will be permitted except where prohibited by any private landowner.*
2. Any islands in Lake Muskoka within the boundary of Muskoka Ward; except as provided for in Paragraph 3 below.
3. *On Browning Island, 25 caliber and under guns and shotguns only will be permitted.*
4. All of lots 1 to 5, Concessions 12 and 13 of Muskoka Ward
5. All those parts of Lots 6, 7, 8 in Concession 13 lying to the north of Part 1, RD 107 (District of Muskoka Water Line Easement) and that part of Lot 9 in Concession 13 lying to the north and east of Rd 107 Part 1;
6. That part of Lot 9 lying west of the Stephen's Bay Road and Lot 10, and Lot 11, in Concession 13

Monck Ward

1. All those lands within the former Township of Monck, lying south and southwest of Highway #118, including the islands in Muskoka Lake;
2. All those part of Lots 1 to 4 in Concession 2, lying north of Highway #118 and all of Lots 3, 4 and 5, in Concessions 3
3. All those parts of Lots 4 and 5 in Concession 4 lying to the south and south east of Beaver Creek; all of Lot 3 Concession 4
4. All of lots 1 through 5 in concession A

Macaulay Ward

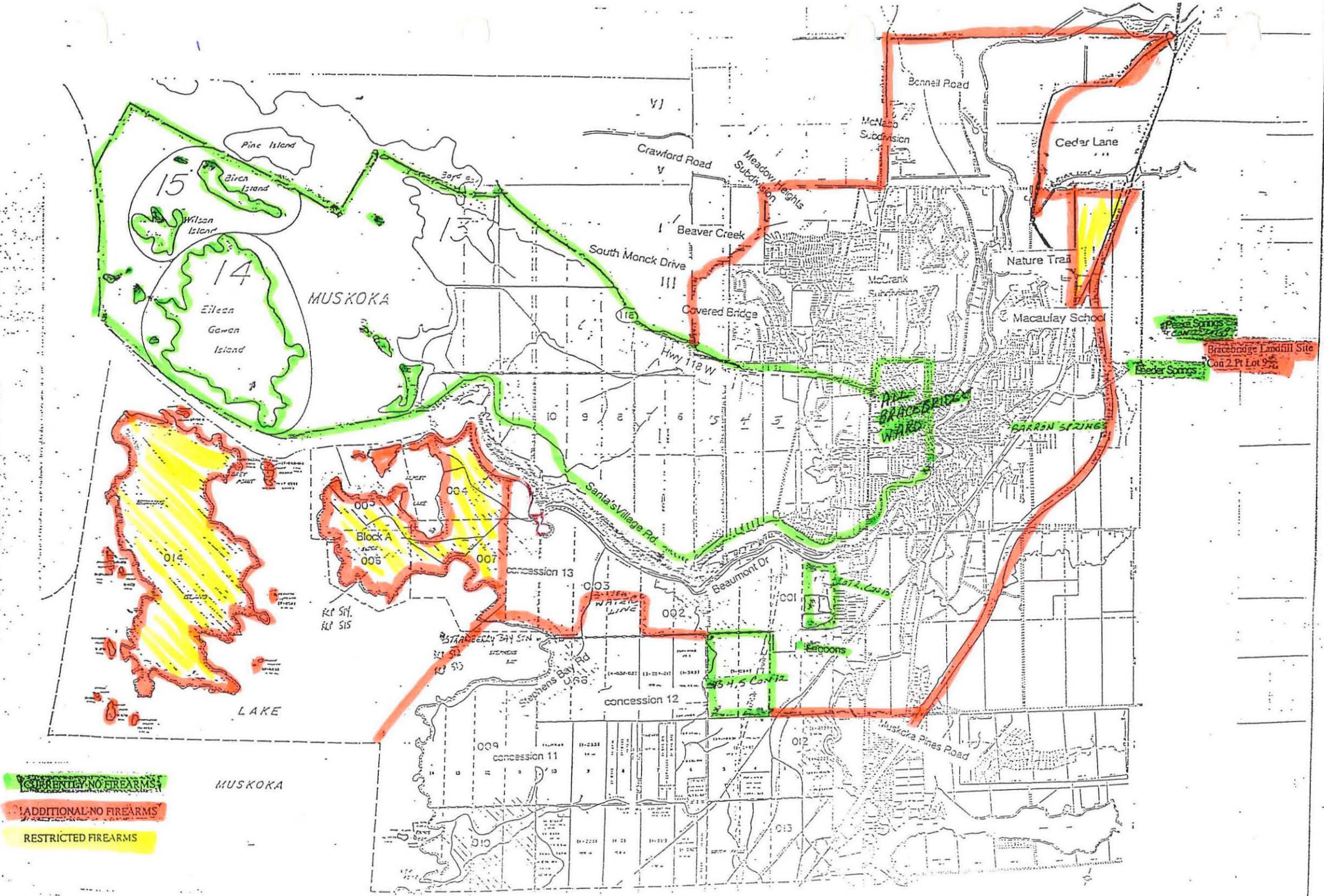
1. All of Lot 5 and that part of Lots 6 and 7 lying west of Highway #11 in Concession 1;
2. All of Lots 5, 6 and that part of Lot 7 lying west of Highway #11, in Concession 2 and those that parts of Lots 8 & 9, Concession 2 known municipally as Peakes Springs and Leeder Springs.
3. All of Lots 1 to 6, and that part of Lot 7, lying west of Highway #11 in Concession 3.
4. All of Lots 1 to 6 in Concession 4, and that 11 acre parcel of land being in Lot 7, Concession 4 lying west of Highway #11 and directly north of the Road Allowance between Concessions 3 & 4; *the use of bows, shotguns and muzzle loaders will be permitted. on the remainder of Lot 7, and that part of Lot 8, Concession 4, lying west of Highway #11.*
5. All of Lots 1 to 6 in Concession 5;
6. All of Lots 1 to 6, in Concession 6; and those parts of Lots 7, 8 and 9 in Concessions 6 & 7, lying north of Cedar Lane, south of High Falls Road and west of Highway #11
7. That Part of Lot 9, concession 2, known as the Bracebridge Landfill site.

Draper Ward

1. All of Lots 1 through 4, and that part of Lot 5 lying west of Highway #11 in Concession 13
2. All of Lots 1 and 2, and those parts of Lots 3 and 4 lying west of Highway #11, in Concession 12;
