Volunteer groomers did their best this year with the unencouraging weather conditions.

Thank you for checking the signage before choosing a trail. Winter trails are groomed specifically for Snowshoeing/ Fat bikes as well as others with tracks for Cross Country skiers.

Hikers (non-snowshoe) are suggested to use other trails which are not volunteer groomed so that we can keep conditions for these specific activities in pristine condition. Parking is also available in the Holiday Park Drive parking lot at the south end of the trails.
