I will do my best to have fun.

HIGH FIVE PRINCIPLES OF HEALTHY CHILD DEVELOPMENT
PARTICIPATION, FRIENDS, CARING ADULT, MASTERY, PLAY.

We will endeavor to provide a program that includes the following:

We will provide choices.

We will provide an opportunity for each individual to participate.

We will encourage friendship and play.

We will ensure an opportunity for skill development, and mastery. We will provide a caring atmosphere.

Conflicts will be handled in the following manner:

Step 1 – Staff will address behaviour by helping the individual to understand the rules and take responsibility for changing their behaviour.

Step 2 – Supervisory staff will meet with the individual to discuss and implement solutions.

Step 3 – Supervisory staff will meet with individual/parent or guardian to establish clear objectives for improved behaviour.

Step 4 – If further negative behaviour continues, individual will be asked to leave for the duration of the program or event. If additional situations occur, at this point, discussions regarding next steps will occur.
