



**BRACEBRIDGE RECREATION

Intent

The Town of Bracebridge Recreation Department is committed to enhancing the quality of life for the community by ensuring age friendly, accessible and inclusive recreation and leisure opportunities.

The Leisure Access Program is a mechanism to support affordable access to recreational opportunities for residents and households living in low income.

Eligibility Requirements

- Town of Bracebridge permanent residents who have lived in the Town of Bracebridge for at least 30 days and who are able to demonstrate residency.
- Households include family members and dependants residing at the same address.
- Full-time Post-Secondary students are not eligible.
- Part-time Post –Secondary students are eligible.
- A combined household income that is at, or below, the following levels:

These numbers are determined by the Statistics Canada Low Income threshold 2019

Leisure Access Passes:

Approved Leisure Access applications are valid for one year from January 1 – December 31, 2021. An approved family may choose from the list below, one pass per family member.

Child / Youth (ages 1 – 19)

- a) Child or Youth 52 passes

Adult / Senior

- a) 52 day passes

Restrictions

- Passes are not redeemable for cash value.
- Passes must be used within the year as passes are not transferable from one year to the next.
- Card or discount transfers are not permitted outside the designated participant's household.
- Participants must register in person for any programs they wish to apply for.
- For children and youth registered programs the registrant must pay, at time of registration, their 50% contribution to the program.
- Leadership Programs require the registrants to pay, at time of registration, for manuals, certification fees and other administrative fees.
- Spring Break, Summer and Winter Camp programs are not included in the programs permitted to have discount.
- Minimum number of participants in a program must be made for registration to proceed.

Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy – The personal information collected on this Leisure Access Application Form is being collected under authority of section 33(c) of the Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy (FOIP) Act. Your personal information will be used to determine eligibility for the Leisure Access Program, program administration, and evaluation. Your personal information will be protected in accordance with the privacy provisions of the FOIP Act.
