

## **Bracebridge Memorial Arena Public Skating**

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- Children 7 years of age or younger must be directly supervised by a participating responsible individual 16 years of age or older.
- Food and drinks not allowed on the ice surface.
- Neither, erratic / excessive speed skating, figure skating maneuvers, horseplay nor games allowed.
- Items such as balls, pucks, chairs, strollers, sticks or any other item which might interfere with the safety of any skater while on the ice surface are not permitted (not including skate assists which are permitted for preschool skaters).
- Refrain from taking headsets, cell phones or hand held electronic devices while skating.
- Do not carry children on the ice surface.
- No sitting on the boards.
- Skate with the direction of all skaters.
- Skates only while on the ice surface.
- The use of a helmet is strongly recommended.
- Please exit the ice surface promptly when buzzer rings.
- **ONE LONG WHISTLE**: EMERGENCY – STOP ALL ACTIVITY, CLEAR THE ICE SURFACE, EXIT TO THE FRONT LOBBY
- **TWO SHORT WHISTLES**: Look to the patroller for direction.

Listen and adhere to the Skate Patrol at all times, he/she is there for your safety. (The Skate Patroller can be identified by the yellow vest he/she is wearing with the name "Skate Patrol" across the back).
