## RULES

### **Bracebridge Sportsplex Indoor Climbing Wall**

---

- Climbers must be at least five years of age to use the climbing wall and have parental or guardian permission. Children under 7 years of age require direct parental supervision.
- All climbers must fill out a Rock Wall Waiver form before climbing and are asked to let staff know of any changes to health.
- A supplied helmet and harness is to be worn at all times on the climbing wall and on the mat.
- Only clean, closed toe shoes are permitted on the wall.
- Chewing gum is not permitted and long hair must be tied back and no hoods.
- Pregnant women are not permitted to climb for their own safety.
- Profanity and unsafe behavior will not be tolerated, if behavior is deemed inappropriate, individuals will be asked to leave.
- There is to be no unauthorized use of the wall at any time.
- Climbers must be at least sixteen years of age to belay another climber.
- Anyone under the influence of non-prescription drugs or alcohol will not be permitted on the wall.
- Photography is prohibited. Please speak to the Reception Desk in you wish to take a photo of your climber.
- Town of Bracebridge staff is responsible for ensuring the auto belay system is operated according to auto belay procedures.
