CODE OF CONDUCT

Bracebridge Outdoor Ice Rinks

Everyone is welcome to skate or play hockey on the appropriate section of this outdoor ice rink.

- This rink is NOT supervised. USE AT YOUR OWN RISK!
- The use of a CSA helmet is strongly encouraged for all skaters.
- Ice surface is open, based on conditions from dawn till 9:00 p.m. 7 days a week.
- In case of accident or injury, please seek appropriate immediate medical attention.
- By engaging in the use of this ice surface, skaters are deemed to have knowledge of, and knowingly assume the inherent risk of skating on ice.
- Please use garbage cans appropriately.
- Drinks food and smoking are all prohibited on the ice.
- Be considerate of noise levels - no excessive radio/stereo volumes.
- Use of foul, offensive or racist language or displaying abusive or threatening behavior is unacceptable and you will be asked to leave.
- Do not fight or play roughly on the rink surface. Refrain from acting in a manner that may cause or contribute to injury of oneself or others.
- Wheelchairs and strollers are permitted on the pleasure skating side with the accompaniment of a responsible person 16 or older.
- No dogs or pets of any kind allowed on the ice surface.
- Keep pucks down on Shinny hockey side of rink, to prevent injury to other users and/or spectators.
- Posted signs concerning weather and ice conditions must be obeyed if the area is deemed unsafe to skate by town staff.
- The Town of Bracebridge is NOT responsible for any injury, loss or damage caused by the use of the rink.

Annie Williams Park Ice Surface only:

- Hockey sticks or pucks are not permitted on the pleasure skating side.
- On shinny hockey side of rink, please keep pucks down to prevent injury to other users and /or spectators.
